Camp Information

(Boys Jr., Girls Camp, Girls Team, Boys Camp & Boys Team)

Insurance – The Missouri State Soccer School has purchased secondary insurance coverage for each camper. Primary coverage for all injuries incurred will be the responsibility of the parent or guardians' insurance carrier.

Injuries – An Athletic Trainer will be present during camp. If further medical attention is needed, local hospital facilities in Springfield will be utilized. Parents or guardians of campers will be notified as soon as possible of any injury requiring medical treatment.

Residence hall – Campers and Staff for all camps will be housed at the Freudenberger Residence hall. Messages may be left for campers at the Freudenberger Front Desk (417) 836-5189 (an attendant is on duty at the desk 24 hours per day).

Camp Regulations

1. Campers are required to sleep in the rooms that are assigned to them.
2. A \$10.00 fee per key will be assessed to any camper losing their keys(s).
3. A soccer camp requires adequate rest in order to be able to perform at one's maximum potential. All campers are to be in their rooms by 9:50 p.m. Lights are out by 10:00 p.m.
4. All sessions will start on time and campers are expected to be in attendance at all sessions.
5. Smoking, alcohol or use of illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
